ANACT to amend the Proceeds of Crime Act, No. 16 of 2000.

[Published 9th December 2009, Extra-Ordinary Gazette No. 58 of 2009.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the National Assembly of Saint Christopher and Nevis, and by the authority of the same as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Proceeds of Crime (Amendment) Act, 2009. Short title.
2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires, "Act" means the Proceeds of Crime Act, No. 16 of 2000. Interpretation.
3. The Act is amended in section 2 by replacing the definition of "property" as follows Amendment of section 2.

“ “property” includes all property, whether movable or immovable, vested or contingent, proceeds from, instrumentalities used in and instrumentalities intended for use in the commission of any money laundering or related offence and whether situated in Saint Christopher and Nevis or elsewhere;”
4. The Act is amended in section 67 by deleting subsection (2) thereof. Amendment of section 67.
